HOUSE RULES

Our “House Rules” are designed to communicate to you the rules of behavior that we expect of each resident, and to communicate our expectation of your participation in daily activities. The rules are burdensome. They are for your safety and well-being, and for the safety and well-being of each resident of the Home of Recovery and Restoration.

We want you to know upfront what behavior and participation will be expected of you here at the Home. We desire that these six months that are ahead of you be the most rewarding months of your life. We are looking forward to seeing you become a new man in Christ and free from your addiction.

THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE FOR THE FOLLOWING BEHAVIORS

FIGHTING – HOMOSEXUAL ACTIVITIES – SMOKING – THEFT

INTENTIONAL DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY

USE OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL – DRUGS – PORNOGRAPHY - WEAPONS

FAILURE TO ATTEND WORSHIP OR BIBLE CLASSES OR GROUP MEETINGS

**YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE HOME IMMEDIATELY IF YOU INDULGE IN
ANY OF THESE ACTIVITIES**

HOUSE RULES

1. Surrender your cell phone, pocketknife, and personal valuables to be put into the safe for security. You will be given a receipt listing all of the items

that you surrendered, and you will receive back your personal items when you graduate from the program.

2. Understand there are **three levels of phone privileges** and at any time these privileges **can be denied** for improper behavior/abuse. No resident is allowed to share their phone with another resident.
 - a. Level 1-no phone
 - b. Level 2- Phone may be granted during working hours and to make phone calls.
 - c. Level 3-Phone may be in personal possession at all time.
3. Understand there may be a more evasive search and or a drug testing if there is “probable cause” to ensure safety of Home of Recovery and Restoration and all who are inside.
4. There is to be no arguing with fellow residents, staff members or volunteers. You must learn to disagree with love and humility.
5. You are not to leave the property without authorization.
6. You are not to make contact with anyone who comes up to or on the property that is not an authorized visitor. Please notify staff immediately.
7. Do not go into “Staff Only” areas.
8. Outside contact will be limited the first 30 days.
9. ****PLEASE UNDERSTAND**** – You will be given a drug & alcohol test at your cost when you return from each visit at your cost (\$10). If you fail the drug or alcohol test you are given the opportunity to begin the program anew, starting at day 1-losing all privileges earned or you may choose to be discharged from the program.
- 10.Keep your room clean
- 11.Makeup your bed every morning
- 12.Wash your clothes on a regular schedule to prevent your dirty clothes from stinking up your room.
- 13.Take a shower at the end of every workday; shower in the mornings of other days and wash your hair to prevent head lice from being spread among the residents.
- 14.Put on clean clothes every morning.

15. There will be proper clothing worn outside of room (Shirt, shoes and shoes/slippers)-no bare feet.
16. Practice good personal hygiene – brush your teeth after every meal, use deodorant as a courtesy to others.
17. Perform your chores per the Chore Assignments Schedule
18. Be at devotionals, classes and worship services on time and ready to participate.
19. Complete all of your study and lesson assignments
20. Be at work on time.
21. **Upon being hired-if resident does not have full tuition covered (\$1000- a month), a small, percentage of paycheck will be requested(up to 50%) to make-up the difference in any lacking funds.-If you have questions please call.
22. Pick up after yourself, dispose of your trash, soft drink bottles, etc.
23. Return all drinking glasses and coffee cups to the kitchen sink.
24. Return all library books to the Library when you finish them.
25. You must ask a staff member for personal hygiene items such as: soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shaving crème, razor, and comb.
26. You must ask a staff member for over-the-counter medications such as: Aspirin, Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Imodium, Allergy medicine, Laxative, Emetrol for Nausea.
27. All prescriptions will be kept secured by Administrators and only dispensed at proper times and only the allotted dose.
28. I acknowledge that all residents are ****subject to random drug tests**** periodically.
29. If you are a smoker, there will be no smoking and nicotine patches can be supplied by family or funds given to purchase such items.
30. You must ask a staff member for pants, shirts, underwear, socks, handkerchiefs, shoes and a coat in cold weather
31. I will purchase on my own, a pair of adequate footwear to be worn in shower. There will be no bare feet anywhere except the individual rooms.
