Visitor Guidelines

- 1. Visits will only be at times, designated by the Administrators of the Home of Recovery and Restoration.
- 2. Only immediate family members can be allowed to make approved visits.
- 3. Visits will only be conducted on Saturday or Sunday, is attending services with the Home of Recovery resident. Any exceptions must be approved by Administrators/Board members.
- 4. Visitors must empty their pockets except for keys before entering Home of Recovery. Purses and handbags shall not be brought into facility.
- 5. Visitors must be modestly clothed. This includes:
 - A. Clothed from shoulder to knee.
 - B. Neither ladies or men shall intentionally show cleavage.
- 6. Visitors will not be allowed to wear clothing that advertises items that are not helpful to the residents of the Home of Recovery. These items include but are not limited to:
 - A. Shirts that promote any kind of intoxicating drink or drug use.
 - B. Any item of clothing that promotes lewdness or indecency.
- 7. Smoking or nicotine of any fashion is not permitted in/on Home of Recovery property.
- 8. Visitors must refrain from offensive language.
- 9. Visits must not exceed the time limit designated by administrators.
- 10. The Home of Recovery and Restoration is working to restore the life of your loved one. Please assist by cooperating with us in helping to achieve this goal.
